These terms and conditions cannot be waived or modified except in writing signed by an authorized Eagle representative and shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Louisiana.

Buyer shall be liable for injury, disability, and/or death of workers or other persons caused by the installation, handling or transportation of product and shall indemnify Eagle against all such liability.
